

### YCS 2019-20 Learning Improvement Plan

The following represents a brief update on our ongoing efforts around our LIP priorities.

Priority Area	Associating Activities & Notes
Literacy	<p>Our <b>One Book One Community SLACKER</b> event began and completed in January 2020. There was good participation within the school, and there was a sense the literacy evening on Jan 30 was a better event. YCS received some feedback from other schools on this event. A book has already been selected for next year. It is "A Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe"</p> <p><b>DECISION: Is there any reason not to follow through with this again in 2020-21?</b></p> <p>Mid- Year F&amp;P assessments were completed for students who were red/yellow in term one. Three LLI groups were created when students reached their reading goals. A number of students have not reached their goals and these were moved into new groups. After the winter break, 3 fresh groups starting.</p>
School Environment	<p><b>Seven Fire Drills have occurred already. We are likely to complete an additional three.</b></p> <p><b>Bus Evacuation Drills took place on October 4.</b></p> <p><b>Four lockdown drills were completed in January 2020. All Grade 8s to YRHS.</p> <p>Students really enjoyed <b>Saskatchewan Express "Escape Room"</b> in January It was well done.</p> <p><b>YHRS Gender Sexual Diversity Club</b> offered to YCS students. YCS is supporting students if interested.</p> <p><b>Parent/Family Engagement</b> remains a provincial/GSSD priority. All K-8 teachers spent Jan 31 with Dr. Debbie Pushor on the topic of parent engagement. Staff will use survey results of Bomboir survey as well as discussions from Jan 31 to prepare "short-term" items and actions for 2020-21 Learning Improvement Plan.</p> <p>Mr. Beatty would like to have Mr. Neibrandt <b>YCS Fitness Room</b>. While a Mr. Beatty Dream, Mr. Neibrandt has been a close second in planning, and for the last month he has been taking "test classes" to create circuits for students. We are in a great position with this room. Mr. Beatty anticipates that a "good sweat" will be shared by students. In addition, the stigma about being "athlete" for PE will be challenged with "being fit." Mr. Beatty expects that the activities in the Wellness Room will be more appealing to some students. We are not done adding some equipment. There are a few more plans, but SCC has given a head start, and Mr. Beatty will be looking for other ways.
